



Korein Tillery law firm makes national 'Plaintiffs' Hot List'

LEGAL NOTICE: The St. Louis-based Korein Tillery law firm, headed by **Sandor Korein** and **Stephen Tillery**, has been named to the "Plaintiffs' Hot List" by the National Law Journal.

The list, which has been compiled since 2003, includes firms that have an impressive record of victories for their clients in high-stakes litigation, the firm said in a news release.

This is the fifth time the company has been named to the list, and it is the only Midwestern firm that is on it. Korein Tillery has offices in St. Louis and Chicago. The other 19 firms on the list are based on the East and West coasts and are major national and international firms with hundreds of lawyers, according to the news release.

By comparison, Korein Tillery has 25 attorneys.

The firm is most noted for the landmark \$10 billion verdict it won against cigarette maker Philip Morris in 2003. Five years after the verdict, the case was remanded back to a Madison County trial court for further proceedings and lawyers in the firm are working on that appeal.
