4 MR. SUMMERS: That was going to be my question,
5 Your Honor. Our hotel by the time we hear, it might be
6 more like 15 minutes, if that's okay.

7 THE COURT: 10 to 15 minutes is fine.

8 MR. SUMMERS: We'll be on the ready, Your
9 Honor.

10 THE COURT: We'll let you know if we hear
11 anything from the jury. I did want to also ask: Is it
12 okay if the Court allows the jurors to leave at the end
13 of each day without counsel being present?

14 MR. ATTANASIO: Yes.

15 MR. SUMMERS: Yes.

16 THE COURT: Okay. Anything else before we just
17 wait for anything that we might hear from the jury?

18 MR. SUMMERS: Nothing further except to thank
19 the Court again for doing such a wonderful job presiding
20 over the trial.

21 Thank you.

22 MR. ATTANASIO: Nothing further. And I would
23 just echo those comments. It was a pleasure to try a
24 case in this courtroom, Your Honor.

25 Thank you.

26 THE COURT: I think I said this before. This
27 was a privilege. This was excellent lawyering. I think
28 this Court has never seen the magnitude of lawyering



1 that we've seen during this trial, so I want to thank
2 you all.

3 So we'll be in recess.
